Korky Paul is a prize-winning illustrator who creates brilliant picture books. In 1986, he illustrated the story of *Winnie the Witch* and her temperamental cat Wilbur. The story was an immediate success with children. Many other picture books have followed and Korky Paul has quickly become a well-known figure in the children's book world.

Korky Paul was born in Harare, Zimbabwe in 1951 into a family of seven children. At an early age, he was already reading comic books and drawing cartoons. After attending a School of Art, he worked for four years for an advertising company in Cape Town. In 1976, he travelled to Greece where he worked as an illustrator of educational books teaching Greek children to speak English until he published his first children's book called *The Crocodile and the Dumper Truck* in 1980.

In 1986, he met the editor Ron Heapy who commissioned him to illustrate *Winnie the Witch*. The book, published in more than 10 languages, won The Children's Book Award in 1987.

Korky Paul lives in Oxford with his wife, the artist Susan Moxley and their two children.
