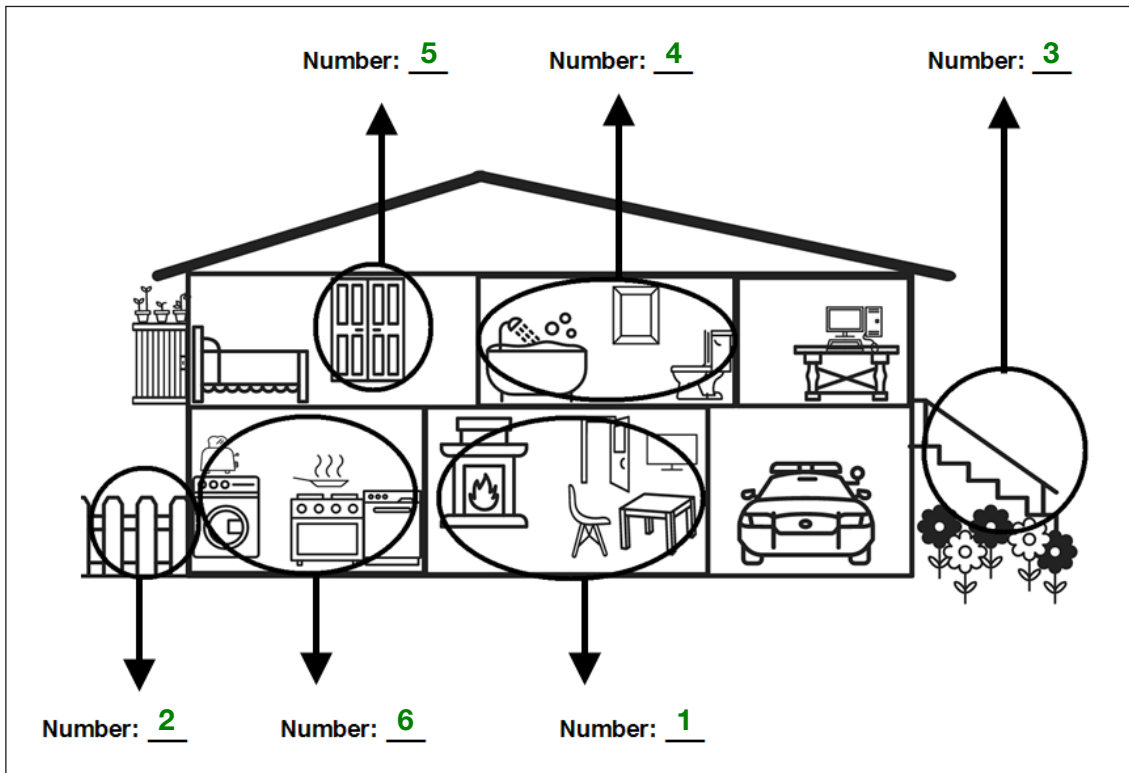

The Course: The 1st mile, every 5th mile, and each km are marked. Clocks will be located at the Start, halfway point of the Marathon, and Ontario Place. The Marathon markers are blue and the Half Marathon markers are orange.

Finish Area: Remember to smile and keep your hands away from your number as you cross the finish line for your official picture by MarathonFoto! Numbers need to be clearly visible so that you can be identified. After you cross the finish line, proceed to the end of the chute as quickly as possible. Medals, food, massages, and medical assistance are all available.

Post Race: Runners will be provided with Gatorade, water, pitas, bananas, and oranges in the Food Tent. A team of Registered Massage Therapists (RMTs) and physiotherapists will be available to all Marathon, Half Marathoner and 10K participants to help work out some of the aches and pains you may be feeling. A very experienced medical team, including chiropodists, will be on hand to assist any participant in need at the medical tent located at the base of the finish chute.

Another extra-tall tower (the *Walkie Talkie*) opens in London, and at its top another bar. But soon it became clear that its 'public garden' on level 35 was not really public (visitors must book limited spaces). But for the price of a cocktail (and 12.5 percent service, even at the bar), you can pass through airport-style security, ascend to the top of the City's latest skyscraper and relax in this exclusive arboretum.

From Sky Pod bar you can see London's skyline but its situation means the main thing you can see is another extra-tall tower, The Shard, just to the south. As the vertical construction in London continues this way, other skyscrapers will become the only view. For now, in summer, an open-air terrace still provides a view to the river Thames and Tower Bridge.

But there's a bar here, remember, serving drinks and food. The cocktails are decent (a Bitter Truth at £11.50 was a pleasant twist on a negroni), many containing champagne. The food is mainly bar snacks (superior cheese boards and the like). Above Sky Pod bar there is the Fenchurch Seafood Bar & Grill and the Darwin Brasserie, where prices rise with the elevation.

Sky Pod looks like a park in the sky, but fits in perfectly in the twenty-first-century City. And it's the only place in the area you can't see the Walkie Talkie, so that's something.

Criteria per corregir la redacció (sobre 25 punts)**Valoració global (coherència i adequació): 10 punts**

10-8 punts: El text respon al tema demanat i incorpora els requeriments que es demanen. Es desenvolupa de manera adequada, ordenada i comprensible.

7 o 6 punts: El text respon a la tasca, però no incorpora tots els requeriments demanats. Es perceben idees desordenades, malgrat que el text és coherent.

5 o 4 punts: El text respon a la tasca, però presenta problemes de coherència i adequació al registre, tot i que pot incorporar o no els requeriments demanats.

3 o 2 punts: L'escrit no respon gaire a la tasca. Resulta difícil de llegir, presenta bastants problemes de coherència, adequació al registre i organització.

1 o 0 punts: Text no avaluable, massa curt, no respon a la tasca i no incorpora cap dels requeriments que es demanen. Text incompreensible.

Riquesa lingüística: 5 punts.

4-5 punts: Utilitza un ventall ampli d'estructures, vocabulari i connectors de manera adequada al context. S'arrisca per aconseguir la comunicació. S'admet algun error de lèxic.

2-3 punts: Utilitza un ventall poc ampli d'estructures, vocabulari i connectors que es repeteixen.

0-1 punts: El text presenta moltes interferències lingüístiques i/o errors. No hi ha puntuació.

Correcció lingüística (morfosintaxi i ortografia): 10 punts

Per cada errada ortogràfica o gramatical descomptem 1 punt; en descomptem 2 si l'errada és greu i dificulta la comprensió del text. No hi ha un màxim de punts a descomptar.
