José Andrés is an international innovator chef, a pioneer of Spanish “*tapas*” in the United States. He is also known for his revolutionary **avant-garde cuisine**. José Ramón Andrés Puerta was born in Asturias in 1969. He **enrolled** in a culinary school in Barcelona at the age of 15. There, he met Ferran Adrià and worked at *El Bulli* restaurant. At the age of 21, he decided to move to the United States. He started to work in Manhattan at a popular Spanish restaurant. In 1993, he changed to the restaurant Jaleo, in Washington and he helped the owners to open more restaurants. In 2003, Andrés started *Minibar* (a new concept of a small and exclusive restaurant). As his restaurants in America enjoyed success, Andrés became more famous in Spain, starring in his cooking show, “*Vamos a Cocinar*” (2005). He also published his first book, “*Tapas*”. In 2006, he negotiated with Robert Wilder to form Think Food Group, making Andrés a co-owner in his restaurants.

In response to the 2010 Haiti **earthquake**, Andrés formed World Central Kitchen, a **non-profit** organisation which provides aid and meals to families and individuals touched by disasters. It helped in the United States and Spain during the COVID-19 pandemic.

In 2012, Andrés was named **dean** of Spanish Studies at The International Culinary Centre, where he developed a curriculum in traditional and modern Spanish cuisine. In 2015, he was awarded a National Humanities Medal for his work with World Central Kitchen.

Today, José Andrés distributes food and provides medical assistance to families in need through its foundation.


