Alejandra Soler Gilabert was born on July, 3rd in 1913 in Valencia City, Spain. She was 101 years old when she died on March 1st in 2017. She was a Spanish politician and a school teacher.

She studied Philosophy at the University of Valencia, **being** one of the first women to graduate from a Spanish University.

Moreover, she was an athlete. Alejandra Soler was one of the first women in the history of Valencian athletics. With a small group of girls, she would run around the current Mestalla **football field** at distances such as 80 meters or 150 meters. In fact, her marks are the first records in the history of women's.

She left Spain in 1939. Later, she was imprisoned in a **refugee camp** and was able to escape. Together with her husband, Arnaldo Azzatti, they moved to Russia. In Moscow, she worked as a teacher. During World War II, she suffered the Battle of Stalingrad, from which she saved 14 students.

In 1958, she was **appointed** Head of the Chair of Romance Languages at the Higher School of Diplomacy in Moscow, a position she **held** until she retired in 1971. She didn't come back to Valencia until that year.

She had a committed life, she fought for freedom and human rights. She also fought for public, universal, egalitarian and **secular** education. A street in the old town in Valencia City **is named after** her. As well as, a school in the Ruzafa neighborhood. She was nominated as an "Honorary Citizen" of Valencia City in 2015. She is also titled the High Distinction of Generalitat in 2016.
