The Nobel Prize in Literature in 2022 was for Annie Ernaux. She is the 17th woman to win the international literary distinction and the fifth in the last 10 years. Annie Ernaux is a French writer and professor of literature.

She was born in 1940 in Lillebonne in Normandy. A few years later her parents moved to Yvetot, where they had a café and grocery shop in a working-class neighbourhood. She studied at a private Catholic secondary school in Yvetot, where she experienced the difference between her working-class background and the other middle-class students.

In 1958, at the age of eighteen, she left home for the summer to **look after** children in a summer camp and in 1960 she travelled to London to work as an au pair. She talks about these experiences in her recent novel called *Mémoire de fille* (*A Girl's Story*). Then she returned to France and studied a **degree** in modern literature at the universities of Rouen and Bordeaux.

Then she married and had two sons. She taught French in a secondary school in Annecy, Haute Savoie. In 1974 Annie published her first book, *Cleaned Out*, an autobiographical novel in which she writes about her move from working-class to middle-class culture **through** education and she also narrates the illegal abortion she **underwent** in 1964.

In 1977 the family moved to Cergy-Pontoise, a new town in the Paris region. Ernaux left secondary school teaching and started working at the Centre for Distance Education, where she worked for 23 years.

She got divorced in 1980. In 2000 she retired from teaching and continued writing, and in 2008 she published *The Years*, considered her best production. In this book, Ernaux writes about herself in the third person for the first time. It is the story of a woman and the evolution of the French society from after the Second World War until the early 2000s. This book was a success and it received **several** prizes.

Her work combines historic and individual experiences, in her book *A Man's place*, she describes her parent's social progression, in *A woman's story*, she writes about her mother's death, or in *Simple Passion* she narrates her passionate affair with an Eastern European man.

On 6 October 2022 she **was awarded** the Nobel Prize in literature "for the **courage** and medical perspective with which she uncovers the **roots**, disaffection and collective prohibitions of personal memory".
