Queen Elizabeth was born at 2.40am on 21 April 1926 at 17 Bruton Street in Mayfair, London, the London home of her maternal grandparents, the Earl and Countess of Strathmore. She was the first child of The Duke and Duchess of York - who later became King George VI and Queen Elizabeth.

Princess Elizabeth and her sister Princess Margaret were educated at home like many girls from wealthy families at that time. After her father became the King in 1936 and Princess Elizabeth was first in line to the throne, she started to study constitutional history and law as preparation for her future role. Princess Elizabeth also studied art and music, learned to ride horses and became a strong swimmer.

She loved horses. The Queen's first pony was a present from her grandfather King George V - a Shetland called Peggy, marking the beginning of a lifelong love of horses. She also had dogs, she had more than 30 dogs during her lifetime. The Queen enjoyed outdoor life. She liked walking in the countryside and spending time with her dogs. The Queen and her husband both loved Scottish country dancing. Each year, during her stay at Balmoral Castle, Her Majesty hosted the annual dances known as Ghillies' Balls, for neighbours, estate and Castle staff and members of the local community.

Queen Elizabeth and Prince Phillip married in Westminster Abbey on 20 November 1947. In the early years of their marriage Princess Elizabeth and Prince Philip lived privately. Prince Charles - now The King - was born in 1948, and Princess Anne two years later.

The couple's life changed significantly when King George VI's got sick in 1951 and in 1952 Princess Elizabeth became Queen Elizabeth. They supported each other through many years of Royal duties. They had two more sons: Prince Andrew, born in 1960 and Prince Edward, in 1964. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh had eight grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren.

After reigning for 70 years, on 8 September 2022, Queen Elizabeth died "peacefully" at 15:10 at the age of 96, with two of her children, Charles and Anne, by her side. Her death was announced to the public at 18:30. She died of "old age", according to her official death certificate.
